Dear Delegate,

We are delighted that you will be joining us for **FinTech on the Seas 2026**, taking place **22-24 June 2026** in the British Virgin Islands.

This year's conference will bring together global regulators, investors, innovators, founders, policymakers, and financial services leaders for three days of high-level discussion, curated networking, and world-class BVI hospitality, with the main conference programme taking place at **Oil Nut Bay and Necker Island**.

Please review the important information below to ensure your arrival, registration, transfers, and overall conference experience run as smoothly as possible.

01. IMPORTANT ACTIONS BEFORE YOU TRAVEL

➤ COMPLETE YOUR BVI ONLINE IMMIGRATION & CUSTOMS FORM

All travellers entering the BVI are required to complete the BVI Online Immigration & Customs Form.

The form may be completed **as early as 72 hours before arrival**, or as late as upon arrival, but it must be completed before seeking entry from an Immigration Officer. Once completed, please save the Immigration and Customs receipts to your mobile device or print them for presentation on arrival.

➤ COMPLETE YOUR DELEGATE REGISTRATION FORM

Please ensure that you have completed your **Delegate Registration Form**. This is essential so the events team can confirm your arrival details, hotel or accommodation pick-up arrangements, correct hotel pick up time, return travel information, dietary requirements, and any special transfer requirements.

Delegates who have not submitted their Delegate Registration Form may experience delays in receiving hotel pick-up and transport information.

If you would like to participate in any complimentary island experiences or “Fun Stuff” activities, please register in advance so we can cater and plan transport accurately.

02. ENVIRONMENTAL & TOURISM LEVY

Visitors arriving in the BVI by air or sea are required to pay a **US \$10 Environmental and Tourism Levy on arrival** at the port of entry. Please have access to cash or a major credit/debit card, as payment options may vary by port of entry.

03. ARRIVAL SUPPORT FOR SPONSORS & SPEAKERS

For confirmed **sponsors and speakers** arriving at **Terrance B. Lettsome International Airport (EIS)**, please look for the **FinTech on the Seas** sign once you deplane or exit the arrivals area.

Our concierge team will be on hand to welcome sponsors and speakers and assist with arrival coordination, including guidance through immigration and customs, onward transport, taxis, ferries, hotel transfers, and urgent event or logistics updates where needed.

Please keep your passport, BVI Immigration & Customs receipts, accommodation details, and event confirmation easily accessible.

Delegates who are not part of the sponsor or speaker arrival arrangements should proceed through regular entry formalities and follow the hotel pick-up and transfer instructions provided by the events team.

04. REGISTRATION STATIONS & DAY 1 PROGRAMME CHECK-IN

There will be **two official FinTech on the Seas registration stations for Day 1 on Monday, 22 June 2026.**

➤ TRELLIS BAY REGISTRATION STATION

Tortola

Delegates departing from Tortola should check in and collect badges at the Trellis Bay dock before boarding the official conference ferry.

➤ OIL NUT BAY REGISTRATION STATION

Virgin Gorda / North Sound Corridor

Delegates staying in or travelling from Oil Nut Bay, Saba Rock, Gun Creek, and nearby Virgin Gorda / North Sound areas should check in at Oil Nut Bay.

Please arrive early enough to complete registration before the start of the Day 1 programme. Your conference badge will be required for access to conference sessions, official transfers, and hospitality events.

05. CONFERENCE VENUES & DAILY TRANSPORT OVERVIEW

Official conference transfers will operate according to the scheduled conference transport times. Hotel pick-up times will be shared with delegates who have completed their Delegate Registration Form.

Please check the conference app and event notices each evening for confirmed departure times for the following day.

Date	Main Venue / Activity	Transfer Notes
Monday, 22 June	Policy & Regulatory Summit - Oil Nut Bay	Registration at Trellis Bay for delegates departing Tortola and at Oil Nut Bay for delegates from the Virgin Gorda / North Sound corridor. After the programme, delegates will transfer to Saba Rock for the opening reception.
Tuesday, 23 June	FinTech Forum Day 1 - Necker Island	Delegates will travel to Necker Island via official conference ferry and tender arrangements. Return transfers will operate after the programme, as scheduled. For delegates staying on Virgin Gorda, regular pick ups and drop-offs will be at Leverick Bay.
Wednesday, 24 June	FinTech Forum Day 2 - Necker Island	The day concludes with the FinTech on the Seas Close-Out Party at the Great House, followed by official evening transfers, as scheduled. For delegates staying on Virgin Gorda, regular pick-ups and drop-offs will be at Leverick Bay.

06. HOTEL PICK-UPS & TRANSFER INFORMATION

Hotel pick-up times will be provided to delegates who have completed the **Delegate Registration Form**.

Please ensure that your hotel or villa details are accurate so the events team can confirm your pick-up location and time.

Delegates are asked to be ready at their confirmed pick-up point in advance of the scheduled time. Late arrivals may miss the official transfer and will be responsible for making their own way to the relevant departure point.

07. VIRGIN GORDA PICK-UPS & DROP-OFFS

For delegates staying on **Virgin Gorda**, pick-ups and drop-offs during the regular scheduled conference departure times will be done at **Leverick Bay**.

Please ensure your Delegate Registration Form includes your accommodation details so the events team can provide the correct instructions and timing for Leverick Bay transfers.

08. EARLY DEPARTURES & OUT-OF-SCHEDULE TRANSFERS

Official conference transfers will operate according to the scheduled conference transport times. Delegates who wish to leave outside official scheduled transfer times should note the following.

➤ DAY ONE - OIL NUT BAY

Delegates who wish to leave Oil Nut Bay outside the official conference transfer schedule may use Oil Nut Bay's complimentary ferry service to **Gun Creek**. This ferry service departs **hourly at 10 minutes past the hour**. Delegates using this service will be responsible for arranging and covering their own onward transportation from Gun Creek.

➤ NECKER ISLAND - OUT-OF-SCHEDULE DEPARTURE

For delegates wishing to leave Necker Island outside the main conference ferry schedule, there will be **one go-fast boat departing after lunch to Leverick Bay**. Seats are limited and will be available on a **first-come, first-served basis**. Delegates using this service will be responsible for their own onward transportation from Leverick Bay.

09. MEALS & HOSPITALITY

➤ MORNING REFRESHMENTS

For delegates departing from **Trellis Bay**, a **breakfast box with juice** will be provided at the Trellis Bay dock before boarding. **Tea, coffee, and water** will be served on the ferry. Delegates departing from other locations should follow the hospitality arrangements shared by the events team for their specific transfer point.

➤ LUNCHESES & EVENING HOSPITALITY

Buffet lunches will be provided during the conference programme. Evening hospitality includes the opening reception at **Saba Rock** and the close-out event at the **R**. Vegetarian options will be available.

Please ensure any dietary requirements are included in your Delegate Registration Form or sent to events@bvifinance.vg as soon as possible.
